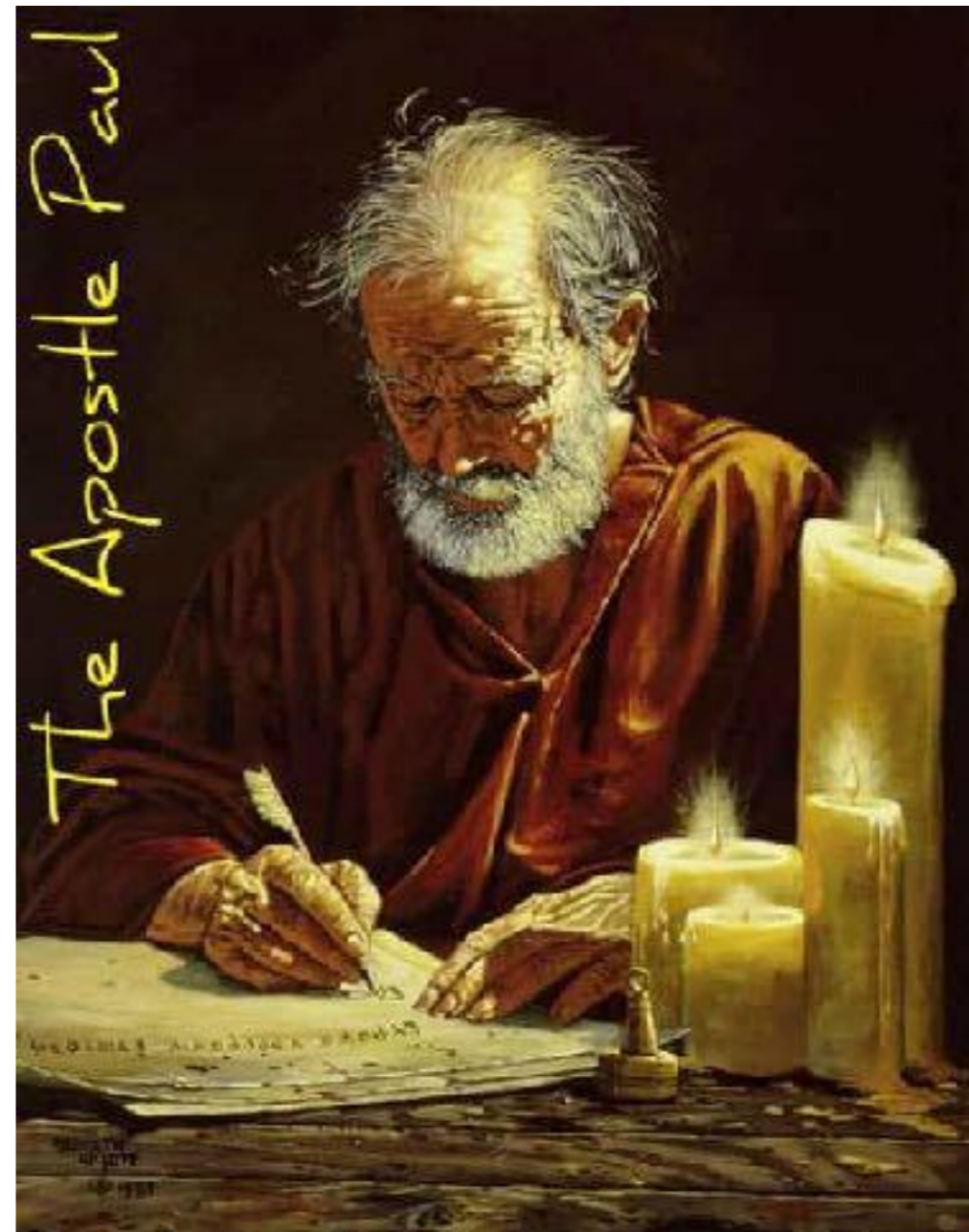

# 1. The Salvation of Paul - 11:1

- Reject = push away, finally and totally cast away



# 2. The Election of Israel - 11:2a

- Corporate Election - provided temporal blessings to Israel and an opportunity to enter into a saving relationship with God; does not provide salvation in and of itself



# 3. The Faithful Remnant - 11:2b-4

- The existence of a remnant is a sign of hope for the whole nation



# 4. The Plan of God - 11:7-10

- What Israel sought had been obtained by the remnant who recognized Jesus as the Messiah
- When you do not step into the light you have then you will step backwards into darkness
