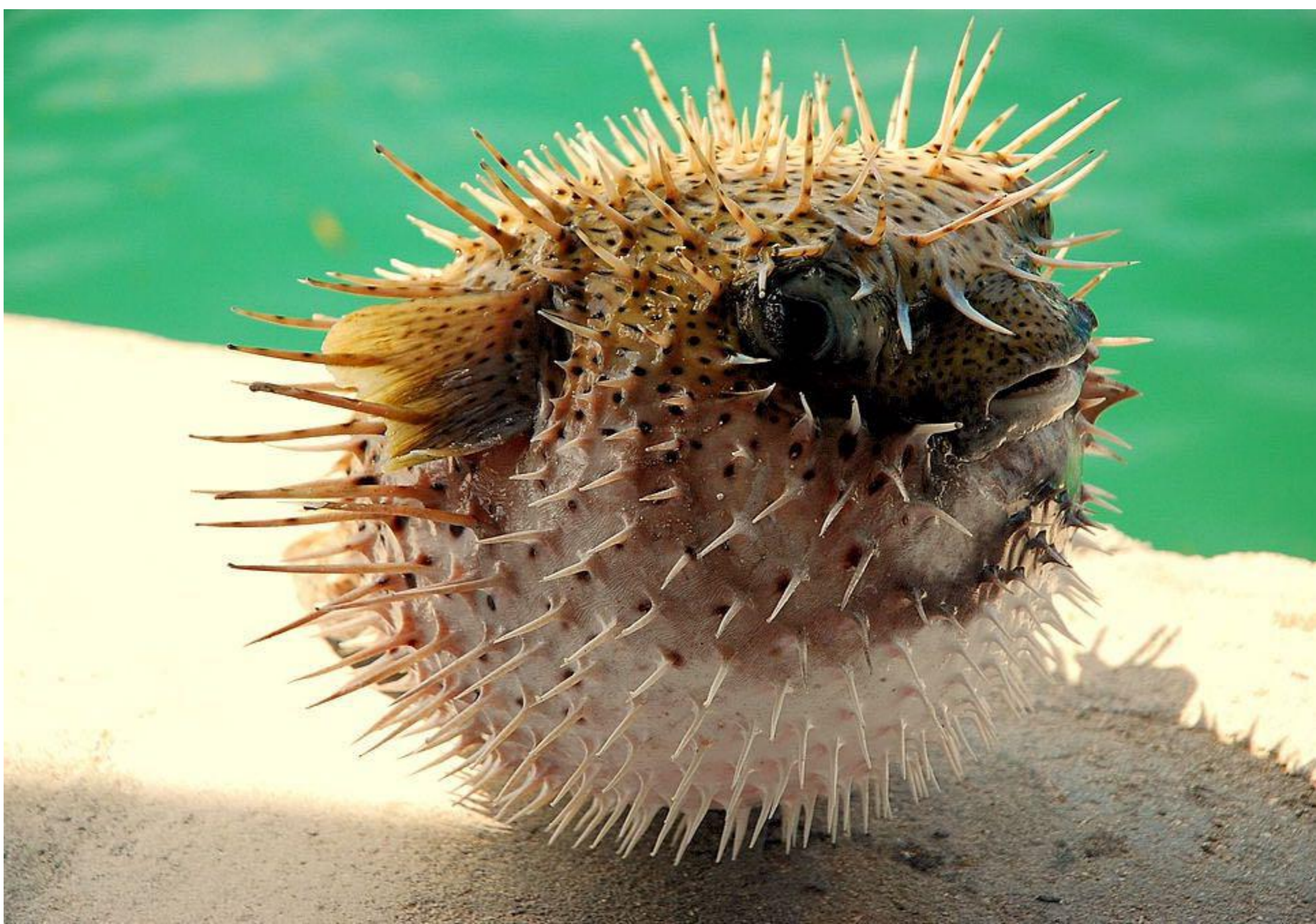

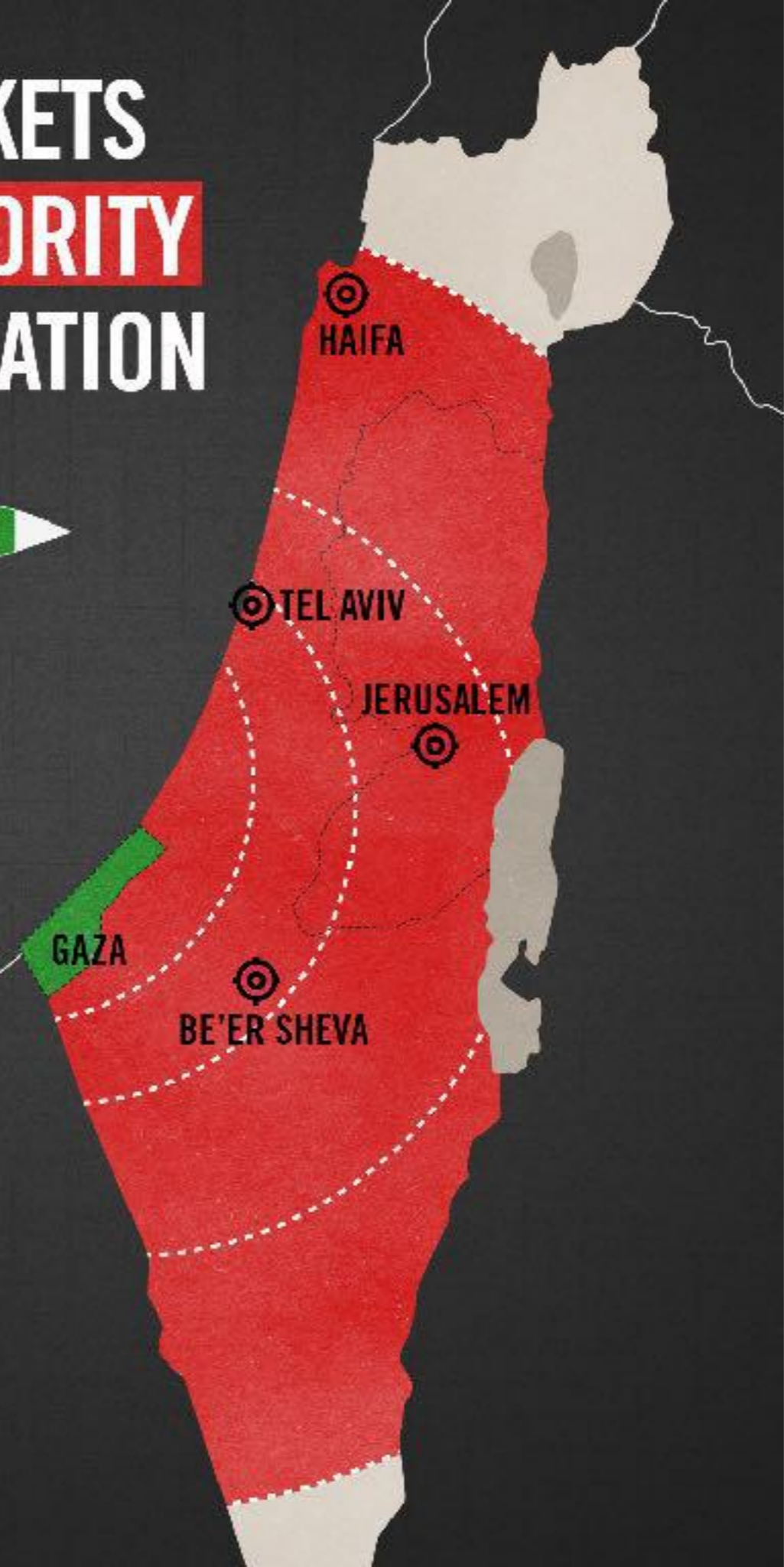

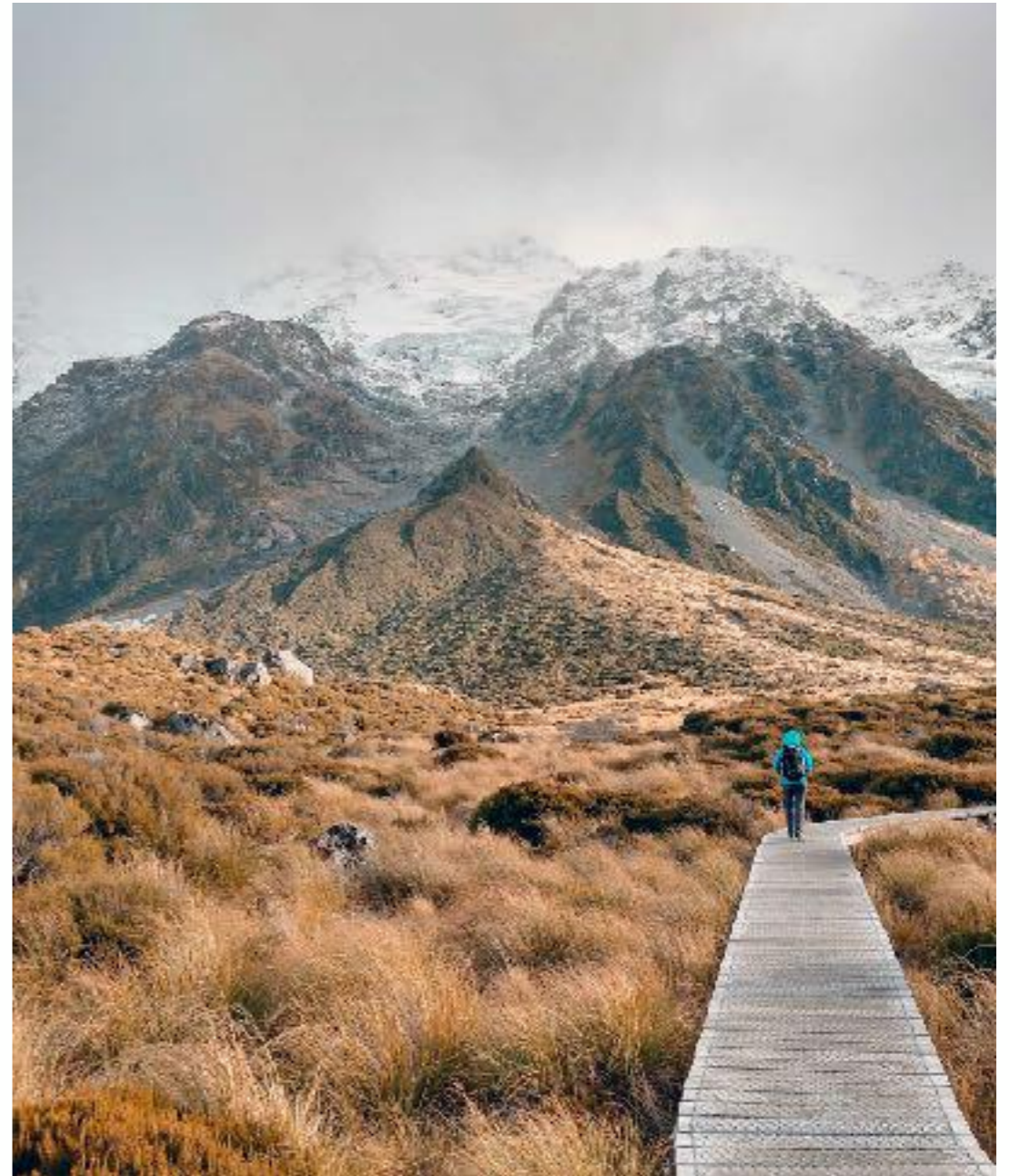
1. The Jewish Nation is Ultimately Loved, But Temporarily Rejected - 11:11-15

- The door is open for the gospel to go to the Gentiles
- God wanted the Jews to be jealous
- God will bring blessing to the world



2. The Gentiles Are Spiritually Blessed, But Morally Undeserving - 11:16-21

- Whole batch = Israel
- Part of the dough =
Remnant of Jewish
Christians in Paul's day
- Root = Patriarchs
(Abraham, Isaac, Jacob)
- Olive Tree = "True" Israel;
the one people of God

3. Israel is Restored in the Future, But the Gentiles are Warned Now - 11:22-24

- The existence of a remnant is a sign of hope for the whole nation



“But if a wicked person turns away from all the sins they have committed and keeps all my decrees and does what is just and right, that person will surely live; they will not die.

None of the offenses they have committed will be remembered against them. Because of the righteous things they have done, they will live. Do I take any pleasure in the death

of the wicked? declares the Sovereign LORD. Rather, am I not pleased when they turn from their ways and live?

“But if a righteous person turns from their righteousness and commits sin and does the same detestable things the wicked person does, will they live? None of the righteous things that person has done will be remembered. Because of the unfaithfulness they are guilty of and because of the sins they have committed, they will die.
