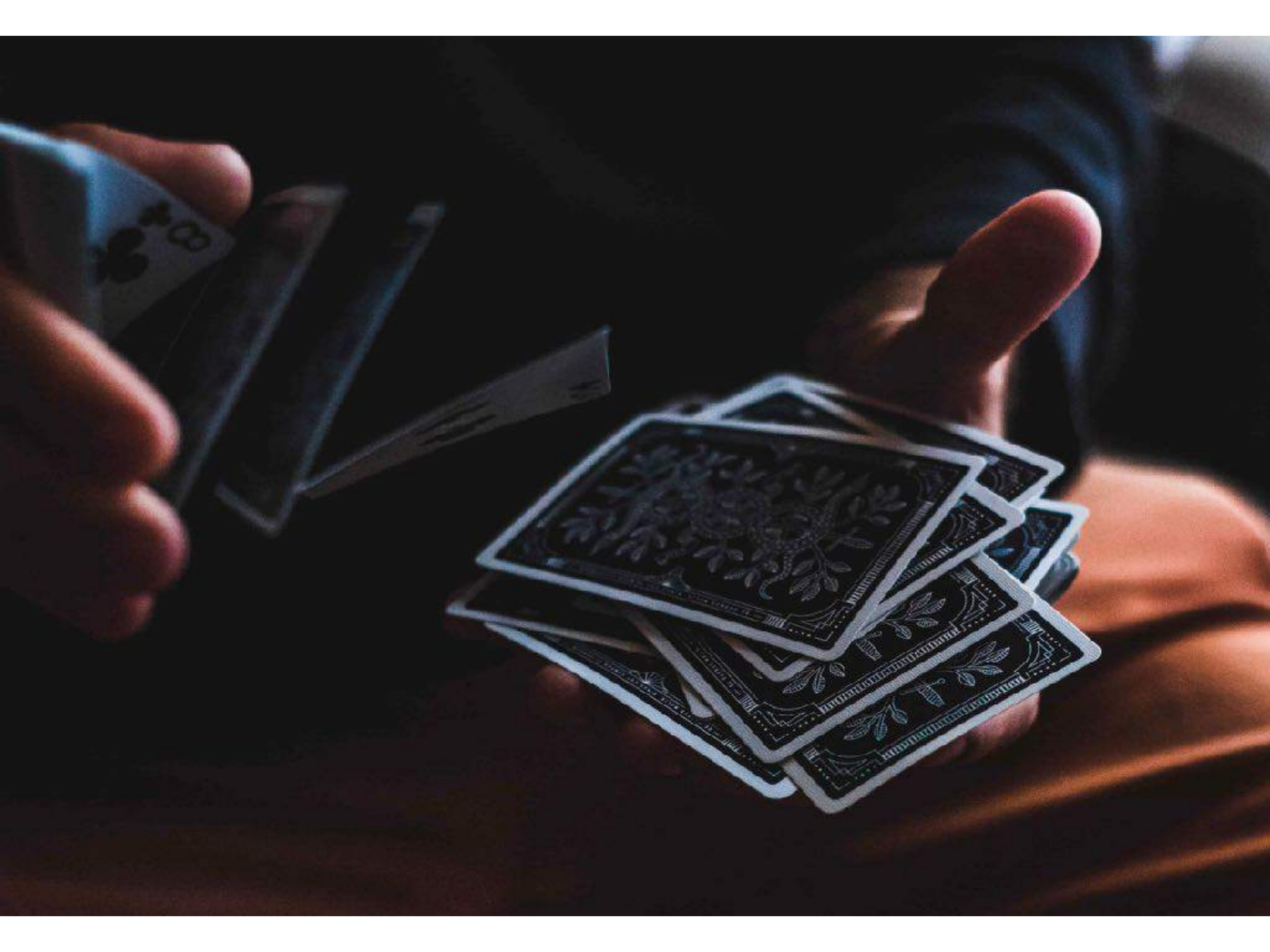

Traditions

- Jewish believers had a hard time and felt it was wrong to give up certain traditions because the traditions gave them a sense of identity





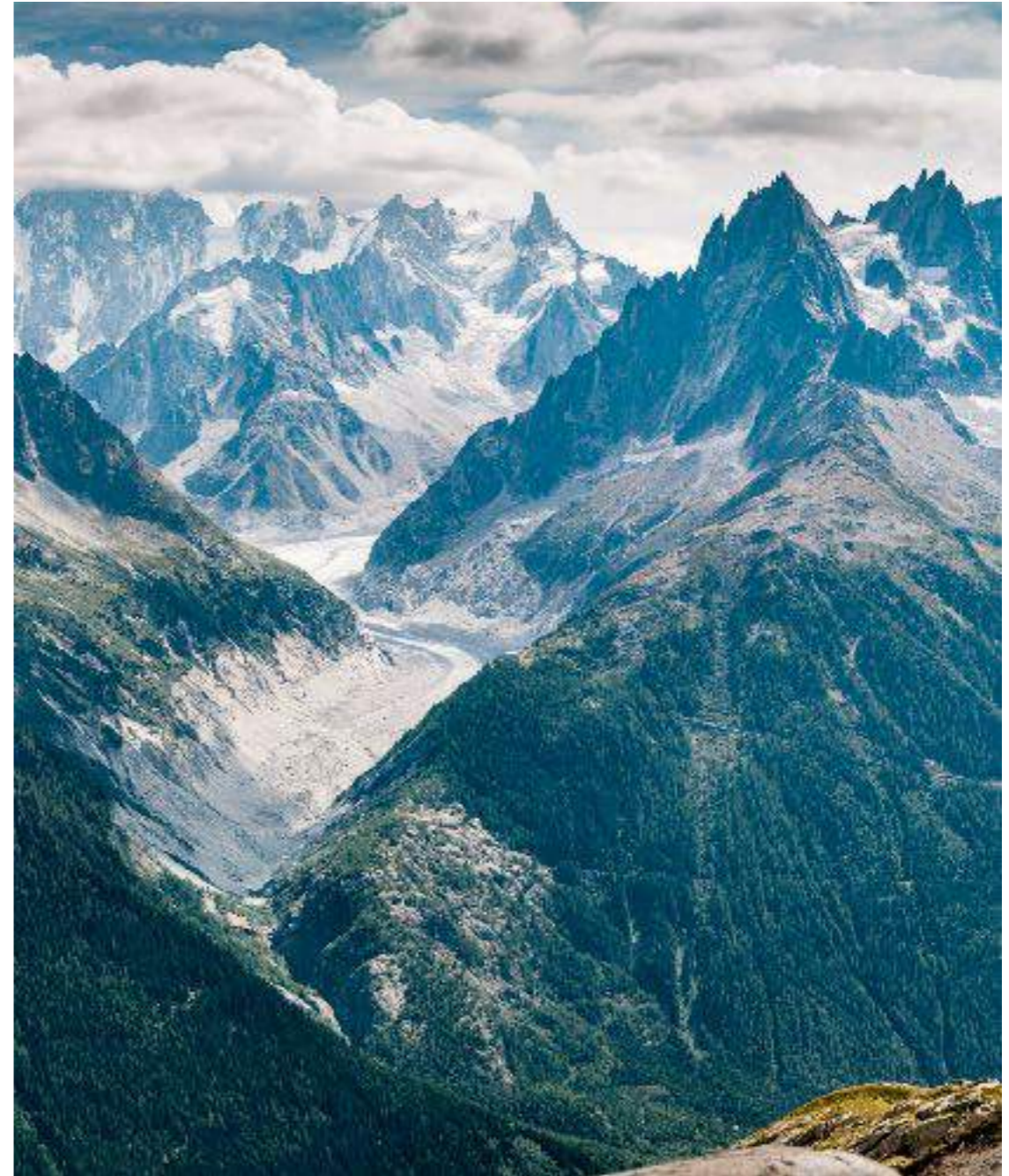
1. There is no place for judging fellow believers on disputable matters of faith - 14:1-3

- Weak = the confidence of one's conscience to engage in a particular activity; the conviction one has about what their Christian beliefs allow them to do



2. Every Christian is a servant of God and must answer to him alone - 14:4-12

- By condemning the strong believer, the weak believer is, in effect, claiming to be that believer's master



3. When our lifestyle choices cause another to stumble, we should put our neighbour's good above our own - 14:13-16

- Don't cause emotional and relational injury by failing to honour another believer's conscience



4. Unity, a kingdom value, is more important than any individual's preferences - 14:16-21

- Primary issues pertain to theology and ethics - to the gospel and moral accountability
- Secondary issues concern externals and tend to be issues of cultural forms



5. Choices not from faith (a firm conviction of appropriateness) are sin - 14:19-23

- “Paul judges it dangerous for Christians to defy their consciences, because if they get in the habit of ignoring the voice of conscience, they may ignore that voice even when the conscience is well-informed and properly warning them of something that is positively evil.” -D.A. Carson



6. We are to serve one another for the sake of unity, following the example of Jesus - 15:1-6

- The strong are to bear the burden that the weak cannot carry themselves
- The purpose of the church is to glorify God - unity is a step to that goal



7. We bring glory to God when we accept one another as Christ has welcomed us - 15:7-13

- Jesus has accepted both Jew and Gentile - to refuse to accept each other is to resist the plan of God
