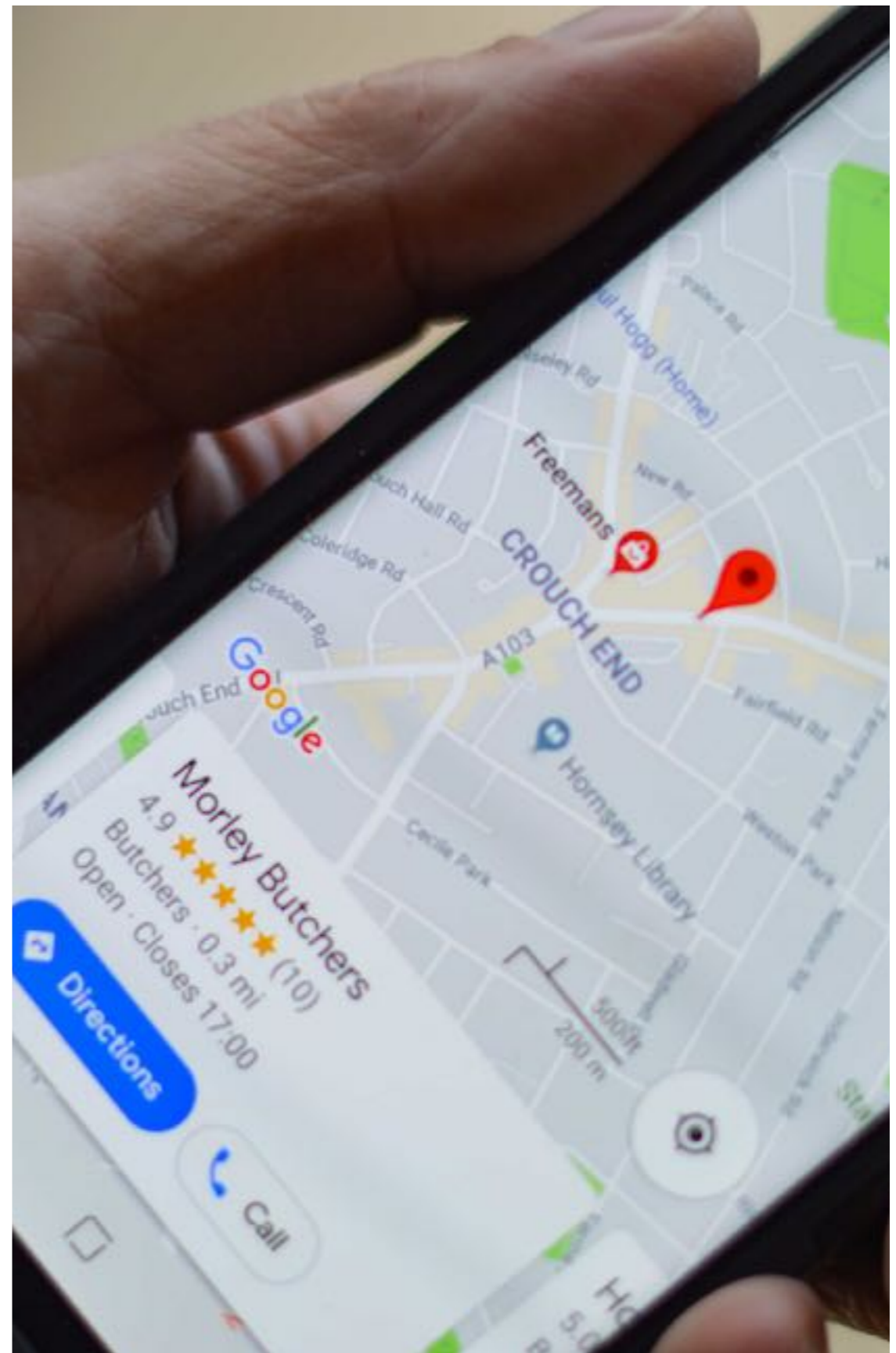

# Repent and Be Baptized - Acts 2:38

- Baptism publicly declares one's repentance and faith - an outward symbol of an inward cleansing
- Not necessary for salvation, but is necessary for obedience



# Train Up a Child - Proverbs 22:6

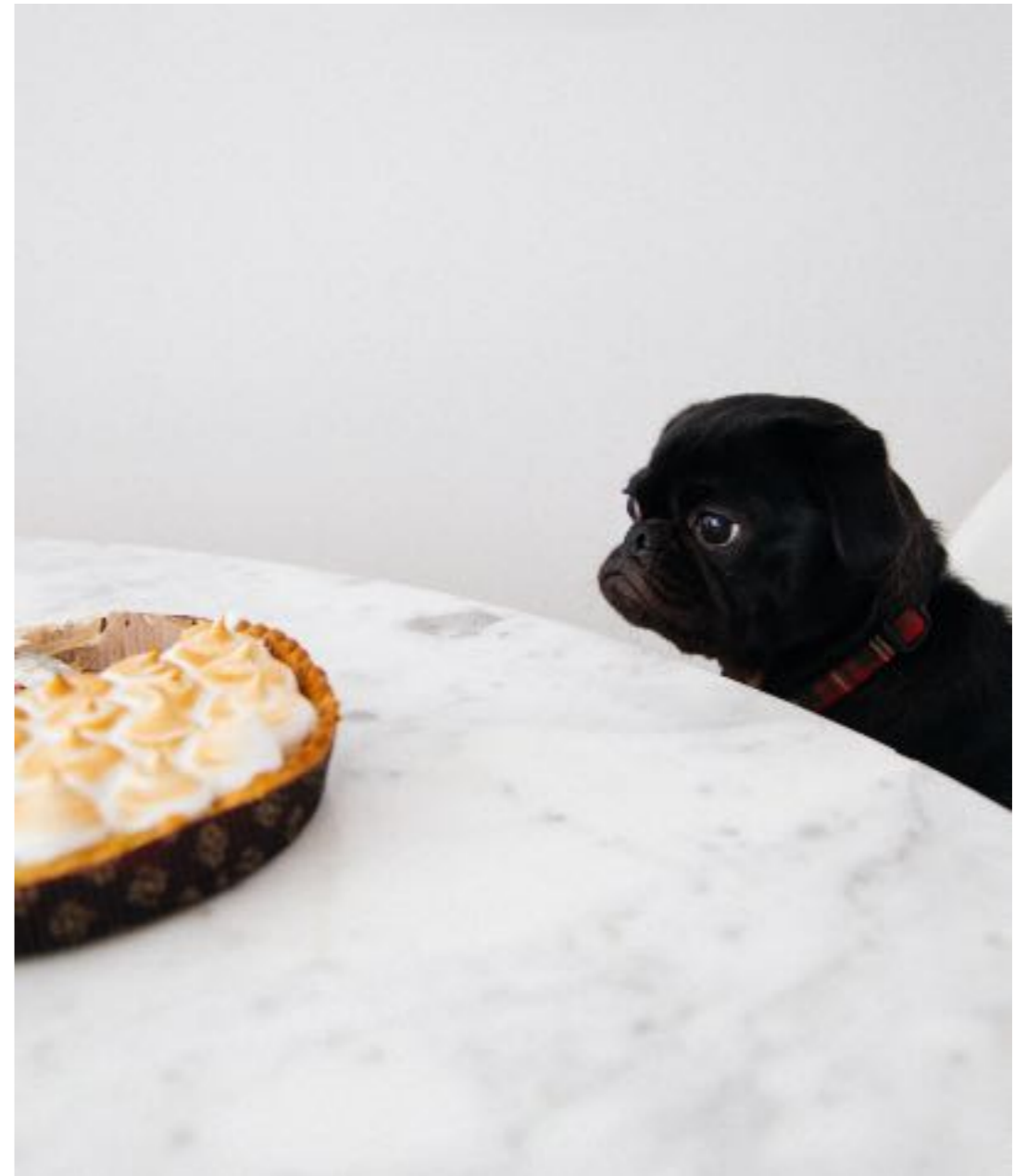
- Not a promise that if you do things right your children will turn out right
- “Let a child have his own way when he is young, and when he is old he will continue to insist on having his own way.”



# Money is the Root of All Evil

## - 1 Timothy 6:10

- Our possessions should not possess us
- The root of all kinds of evil - NOT - the root of all evil
- All sin is rooted in the cravings of a sinful nature that pursues its own pleasure and glory



# Where There is No Vision - Proverbs 29:18

- This verse is not talking about a vision statement or planning for the future
- When the Bible is ignored, you lose the ability to sort out right from wrong, and restraint is ignored
